The teens-only summer reading program for ages 12-17 explodes with art, live music, poetry, and other creative expressions. Besides winning a cool book, earn a chance to win a Flip video camera (one raffle in each branch) by playing the summer reading game which uses coupons and a bingo-style playing card.



Experience a wide variety of reading over the summer—not only “real” books—books on CD, downloadable books, comics, magazines, newspapers, and even online reading. Complete more spots on your game card by attending special library programs, activities with your family and community, and even while having fun with your friends!

The special programming lined up for you is at every Deschutes Public Library branch and includes a visit from Portland-area artist and Japanese culture educator, Yuki Martin. Yuki leads a workshop on creating manga-style drawings. Each branch has a variety of other fun events, including a matinee viewing of the hit film *Twilight*, based on Stephenie Meyer’s book.
