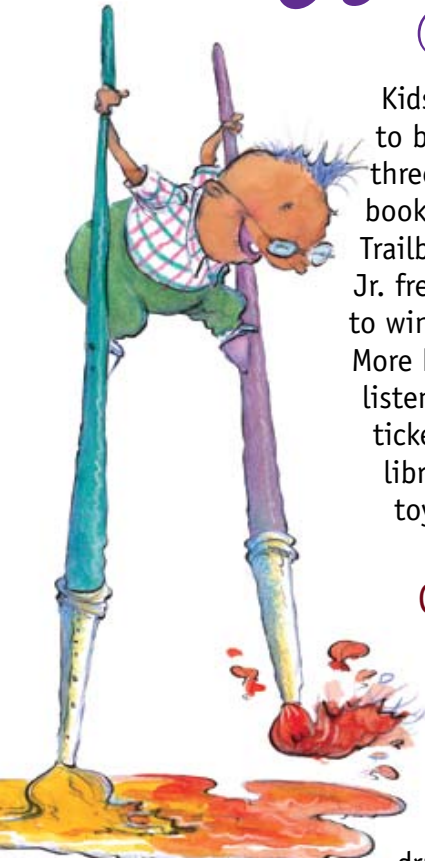


Children's Summer Reading Program June 13
