Accessing LearningExpress Library

1. Go to the Deschutes Public Library web page at <http://www.deschuteslibrary.org>.
2. Click once on Explore.
3. Click once on Online Resources.
4. Click once on LearningExpress Library under Do-It-Yourself.
5. Click once on View LearningExpress Library.
6. Type in your 14-digit library card number and click Connect.

Getting help with LearningExpress Library

Help is always available online when using *LearningExpress Library*. Click once on Help at the top of the page.

Creating an Account

You must create an account the first time you access *LearningExpress Library*. You will logon to this account each time you wish to use the database. To create a new account:

1. Click once on Register.
2. Complete the registration form and click once on the Register button.
3. The next time you use the database, type in your username and password and click Login under Returning User Login.



Taking a Practice Test

1. Login to your account in *LearningExpress Library*.
2. Search for a test or tutorial using the search box in the upper left corner or click on one of the Learning Centers to browse for a test or tutorial.
3. Click on a test or tutorial category to view the tests/tutorials.
4. Select a test or tutorial and click Add to My Center.
5. Once you have selected your tests, click on My Center at the top of the page.
6. Click once on Start or Continue to begin or resume a test. Most tests are timed and you may stop and continue at any time.
7. From the Test Instructions page, click once on Start to begin the test.
8. Upon completion of the test (or if time had expired), click once on Score My Test to obtain your test score.
9. If you need to stop a test in the middle, click once on Finish Later to complete the test later.

Always remember to Sign-out once you have finished taking a text.
