

# NoveList

An Online Resource for finding  
a good book



*NoveList* is an easy and fun-to-use one-stop source for descriptions and expert recommendations on classic, mainstream, or genre fiction titles covering a wide range of subjects for all age levels.

## Accessing NoveList

1. Go to the Deschutes Public Library web page at <http://www.deschuteslibrary.org>.
2. Click once on Explore.
3. Click once on Online Resources.
4. Click once on NoveList under Books and Reading.
5. Click once on View NoveList.
6. Type in your 14-digit library card number and click Connect.

## Getting Help with NoveList

Click once on Help at the top of the screen. A new window opens. Use the menu choices to the left to locate information about using *NoveList*.

## Searching NoveList

- Type in an author, title, series name, or keywords in the search box at the top of the screen.
- Click once on Search.
- Note that Advanced Search is available. Click on the link below the Basic Search Box to access.

## Viewing Results

Searches resulting in more than one title are displayed 10 at a time. Click once on Next to view the next set of results. To narrow your search by Genre, Storyline, Pace, Tone, Writing Style, Subject, or Location, use the menu options to the left of the screen.

Click on the title for a detailed description of a particular book. To locate similar titles, scroll down and look for Search for More to the right of the screen. Select the appropriate information and click once on the Search button.

## Printing Results

To Print a list, begin by selecting the titles by clicking on Add to folder below each record and then click once on Folder at the top of the page. Select the titles to print, click once on the Print link at the top of the list, and follow the on-screen instructions.

To Print a record, click once on the Print link at the top of the record and follow the on-screen instructions.

Lists and records may also be set via E-mail. Select E-mail at the top of the list or record screen and follow the on-screen instructions to send information to your e-mail account.

## Special Features

- Recommended Reads Lists: Genre lists of books for adults, teens, and kids.
- Author Read-alikes: Articles listing similar writing styles and subjects for your favorite authors.
- Book Discussion Guides: Great for book clubs.
- Award Winners: Listing of literary awards and recommended reading lists. Note that there are lists specific for adults, teens, and kids.
- **Readers' Advisory Toolbox:** Provides everything you need to assist yourself and others make informed decisions about the next book they wish to read. Includes **NoveList Newsletters, Learn About Genres, readers' advisory training materials**, and more.
- Teaching with Books: Provides materials developed specifically for kids. There are articles and guides for all grade levels from pre-school through high school.
