



HOW TO: Transfer a Kindle Book via USB

If you do not have access to WiFi, you will have to download your Kindle Book to a computer and transfer it to your device using a USB cord.

1. On the confirmation page after clicking "Get Library Book," choose "Manage Your Content and Devices." Or if are not on this page, navigate to "Manage Your Content and Devices" by clicking "Account & Lists" under your name at the top of the page. Under "Digital content and devices" click "Manage content and devices."

2. Click the three dots under the action header next to the book you want to transfer.

3. In the window that pops up, select "Download & transfer via USB."
4. Click "Download" in the "Download & Transfer via USB window."

5. Depending on the browser your using, the file might download differently. Follow the following instructions to find the file that includes the title of your book.

- o PC Users: Navigate to File Explorer and the "Downloads" folder. > Downloads
- o Mac Users: Navigate to Finder and the "Downloads" folder. Downloads

6. Plug your Kindle into your computer with its USB cord.
 - o Mac Users: Open the Kindle drive on your desktop. Open the Kindle's "Documents" folder.
 - o PC Users: A dialog box will appear after plugging it in, choose "Open folder to view files." Open the Kindle's "Documents" folder.



7. Drag the ebook file from your downloads folder to the Kindle's documents folder.
8. Eject the Kindle from the computer once it is done downloading.
