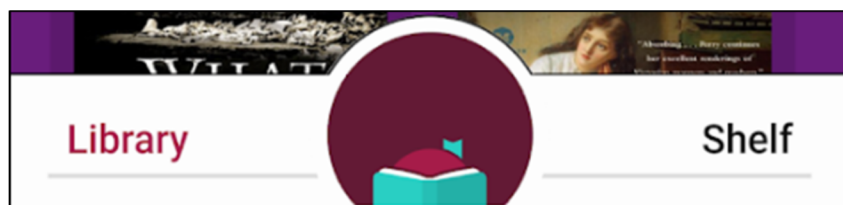




HOW TO: Get Started Using Libby for Audiobooks

These instructions guide you through the steps needed to use the **Libby** app on your phone or tablet to listen to audiobooks.

1. Open Libby on your device. If you haven't yet installed Libby and need help, see the guide to Using Libby.
2. Switch to the *Library* tab. Libby had three tabs at the bottom of the page:



- The *Library* tab lets you search for something and borrow it from your library.
- The *Recently Read* circle will turn into the cover of the current book you're reading. Press it once to jump to where you left off.
- The *Shelf* tab lets you see everything you have checked out and items you have on hold.

3. Select the *Library* tab to search for an audiobook.

4. Audiobook search settings. After selecting the *Library* tab, press the orange *Preferences* menu and from format select Audiobooks. You have to select Apply Preferences for the new setting to work.

5. Search or browse for an audiobook. Now if you browse or search in the *Library* tab you will only see audiobooks. Once you borrow an audiobook you'll find it on your shelf. By default you need to be connected to WiFi for your audiobook to download.
