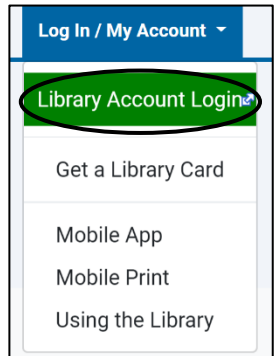




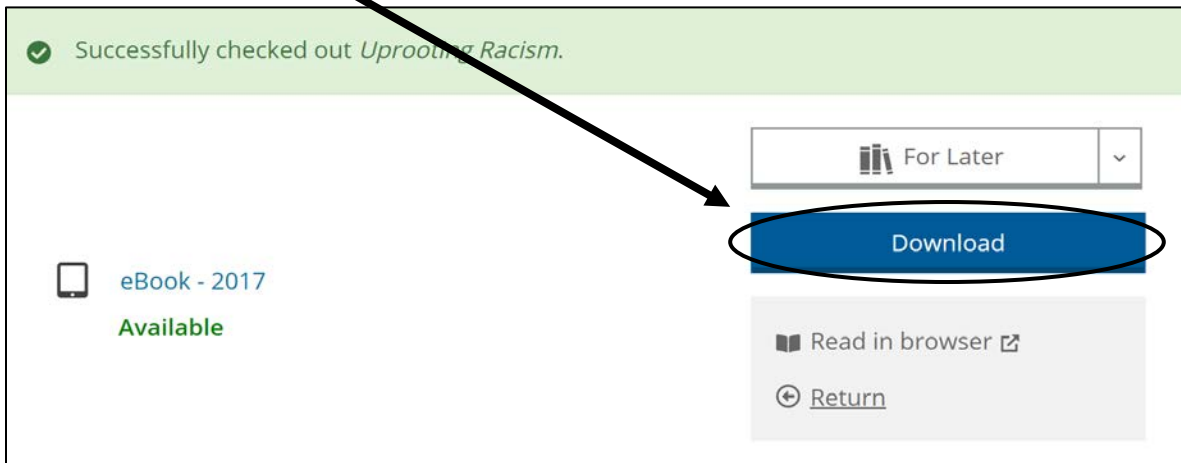
HOW TO:
Borrow Books via OverDrive Kindle

These instructions guide you through the steps to borrow an ebook via OverDrive and have it delivered to your Kindle device to read. OverDrive does have an app for Kindle Fire, however the easiest way to deliver a book to any Kindle is via the library's online catalog.

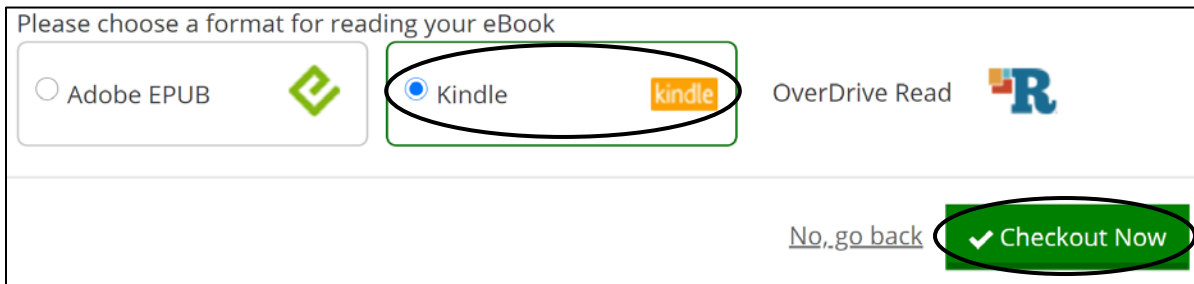
1. Login to your library account by clicking "Log In / My Account" at the top of the library's webpage, then "Library Account Login." On the next screen, login with your 14 digit library card number (no spaces) and PIN/password (usually the last 4 digits of your phone number).
2. Find the ebook you'd like to borrow and click "Checkout Now." Then click "Checkout Now" again when the box turns blue.



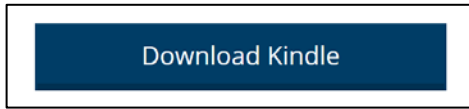
3. You'll get a green bar showing your checkout was successful and the option to "Download," "Read in Browser," or "Return." Click "Download."



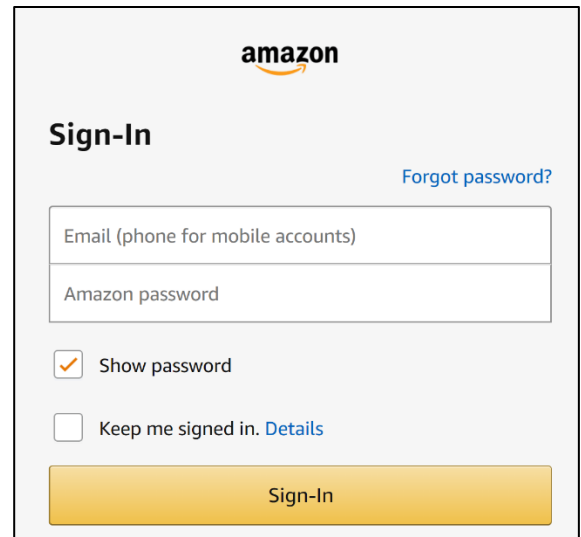
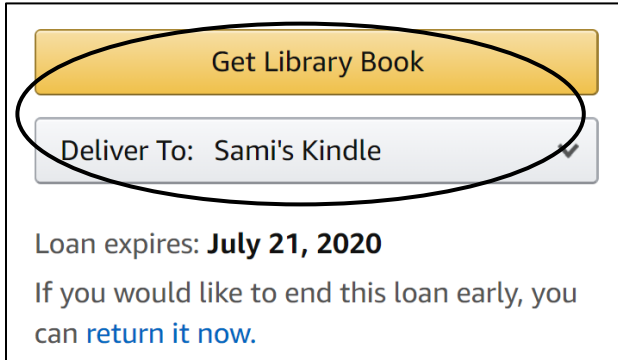
4. Click "Kindle" then "Checkout Now."



5. Click "Download Kindle." You'll then be directed to Amazon. Login to Amazon with your Amazon credentials (email/password).



6. Once you're logged into Amazon, you'll see the book's landing page, and information on having it delivered to your Kindle. Choose/confirm the device you would like the book delivered, and click "Get Library Book."



7. You then get a confirmation that it has been delivered. If you'd like it sent to another device you can do this now, or click "Manage Your Content and Devices" to return or manage your ebooks.
